Mark Koegler, ASLA, of Minnetonka, is a landscape architect with over 30 years of experience as a municipal planner and a consulting planner. He is a member of the American Planning Association, is past president of the Sensible Land Use Coalition and is a returning member of the State Designer Selection Board.

Rebecca J. Lewis, AIA, ACHA, CID, of Duluth, is experienced in architectural practice specializing in healthcare architecture, gerontology and codes and standards guidelines. She succeeds Angela DeLong-Gatzlaff as the American Institute of Architects (AIA) representative to the board.

Maurice Roers, of St. Paul, has a decade of experience in urban planning in Minnesota and New Zealand. He is a graduate of Macalester College, St. Paul, and received his Master's Degree in Public Policy and Urban Planning from Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government/Graduate School of Design.

The seven-member State Designer Selection Board selects primary designers through a qualification-based selection process for proposed state agency construction projects with an estimated cost greater than \$2 million, or a planning project with estimated fees greater than \$200,000. The board also recommends two finalist primary designers for the University of Minnesota and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities for their final selection for projects involving construction or remodeling estimates greater than \$2 million or a planning project with estimated fees greater than \$200,000.
